


Focus on the EsophagoGastric Junction: The Reflux Barrier & Antireflux Surgery

Objectives:

- Understand components of the antireflux barrier
- Review the AFS Hiatus Grade (AFS HG) classification
- Understand the AFS mechanisms of GERD and antireflux surgery (ARS)
- Understand the endoscopic characteristics of commonly performed ARS

Reflux is related to a small anatomic region called the esophagogastric junction (EGI). Therefore, it is fitting that the upcoming AFS PG course is entitled: "Focus on the esophagogastric junction: the reflux barrier & antireflux surgery". In this course, participants will learn the new AFS classification of EGJ integrity that stresses both the importance of the flap valve and the degree of hiatal disruption. There will be a discussion on the mechanism of GERD and the principles of antireflux surgery (ARS). A major emphasis in this course is to learn the endoscopic characteristics of the gastroesophageal flap valve after ARS and how that correlates with the geometry of the fundoplication. Improved understanding of fundoplication geometry and its endoscopic characteristics should help surgeons optimize current and future antireflux operations.
